Man Overboard – Jonaн 2:8-9

"Salvation comes from the LORD" (Jonah 2:9)

This week we begin a new series in the book of Jonah. Of the twelve books called the minor prophets, Jonah is almost certainly the one we know best. If you've grown up in church, you'll be very familiar with the story of Jonah, having heard it many times in Sunday School.



Even if you didn't grow up in church, it's likely you know something about Jonah (and the whale). You may also

recognise the name being associated with a person who brings bad luck. In the past, British sailors were notoriously anxious about 'having a Jonah aboard'.

As much as we know about Jonah, there are probably quite a lot of things still to learn. Jonah is a tale of the unexpected. Almost everything in Jonah is unexpected. This morning we'll begin with an overview of the book and a focus on its most famous verse. From the belly of the fish, Jonah comes up with a succinct summary of the message of the whole Bible: "Salvation comes from the LORD". On the utterance of those words, he is vomited out to a whole new life.

Prayer Diary 29TH April – 5^{TH} May

Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace at all times and in every way. 2 Thessalonians 3:16

Monday Pray into the above verse so that you can come to the Lord this week with your head cleared of the worries and sins that can burden us and prevent us hearing God speak to us, know His forgiveness and peace so you can focus on prayer. Please pray today for any charities you know of that members of VBC are employed in. Many of them are Christian charities such as Linking Lives, Eastbourne. Eastbourne Blind Society is another. Please pray for opportunities to bring Christ to people in our community.

Tuesday Please pray for the work that Neil Hilton (former youth worker at VBC), and his wife, Jess, now do among vulnerable people in Brighton. Pray that many will give their lives to Jesus, that the community will become safer and happier. Pray too for safety and God's guidance for them both.

Wednesday The Community Fridge and Café happen today. God's eyes will be on all efforts to reach "the lost" so pray for Him to bless this project and be powerfully at work in the hearts of all who come along.

Thursday Bible academy level 1 happens alternate Thursdays, and Deep Dive on alternate Sunday evenings. Pray for all the participants to have their eyes opened by God. And pray that God will give Jez the words to say, and sensitivity to each person's spiritual journey.

Friday Vicky B's has been going for so many years! We must continue to bring before God it's valuable outreach and the volunteers involved. Pray for all that goes on with parents and children there.

Saturday We continue to pray for Ukraine through Sandra's weekly update. Sometimes she includes tragic personal stories of individuals who have come to the centre for aid. Please remember particularly the two brothers who we recently heard about, fighting each other a lot because of their trauma; and the young girl who arrived with severe head lice and was suffering neglect. They need our ongoing prayer, and we pray that God will restore their hearts and minds, and they will know His love.

Sunday Please pray for safety for all those meeting in secret, around the world, to worship God. They will risk everything to worship and pray together. Also, pray for churches that openly meet but risk being burnt down, or the members and pastors murdered by extremists. Please pray that those seeking the gods of other faiths will have a "Damascus Road" experience and give their lives to Christ in a mass revival. Think big in prayer. And may God show all Christian communities where He wants to lead us this Sunday morning. May God bless you. Amen.
