
#### **CHRISTMAS POST**

# FOR PRAYER FUEL

#### Prayer Diary 11<sup>TH</sup> - 17<sup>TH</sup> December

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope." Romans 15:13

**Monday** Listen to the news and pray for all those nations who are hoping for peace in their lands. Pray for those who are being affected by the numerous conflicts around our world and for whom hope seems lost. Pray for peace-making politicians and for the United Nations as they seek to resolve huge issues.

**Tuesday** Pray for those who are looking forward to spending time with family in the coming weeks. Lift to God those who are lonely, who have lost loved ones, or who are estranged from friends and families. Ask God's mercy on those who have lost the ability to recognise their loved ones and pray that this will be a time of hope and love, regardless of circumstances.

**Wednesday** Pray in hope of God's healing hand on those who are sick or in hospital. Ask God to give us words of comfort and hope to those we are visiting, to those we send Christmas cards to, and to those who we speak to on the phone. Ask that, by His Holy Spirit, folk who need hope will be laid on our hearts and we act to reach out to them. "The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His steadfast love." Ps 147:11

**Thursday** Hold in your hearts those who find this time of year a trial. Pray that physical needs for food and shelter will be met in their communities and by agencies such as Foodbank, NetworX and Winter Night Shelter. Pray for CAP clients known to us who need hope in tough times. Give thanks to God for those for whom this Christmas will hold much more hope because they are debt free. Praise God for those who have come to know the living hope of Christ in their lives.

**Friday** Give thanks for the hope that the ministries here at VBC give to different people - for Flow Cafe and Vicky Bees, for Community Fridge and for the forthcoming Carol and Christingle services. Pray that the words of encouragement visitors and members hear will flourish in hearts, heal hurts and stir the real message of the hope we have - "For God so loved the world ..." John 3:16

**Saturday** Praise God for sending His Son. Ask for help to focus on the hope He brings and for help to remember the real meaning of Christmas. "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; He has sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound .." Isaiah 61:1

**Sunday** Give thanks to God for the hope we have in His Word. Pray for those leading us as we study scripture together, especially pray for Chris and give thanks for his passion and skill. Ask that we are refreshed and inspired by messages he brings and be thankful that we can revisit the message of hope every year.
