

Have you ever felt disappointed and let down? An expectation not met? Life is full of disappointment and sometimes it can be hard to negotiate your way through your feelings.

This week is our All-Age Service and we are looking at the story of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus after the resurrection. The two disciples in the story were feeling despondent and sad, their hopes of Jesus redeeming Israel had been dashed. Yet unknown to them, Jesus walks with them, through their sadness, and reveals the bigger picture of God's purposes. When He eventually reveals Himself the disciples are transformed. This could be the picture of our life, not recognising that Jesus is walking with you in difficult times, guiding you through. Where are you in the story? Despondent, filled with hope as you discover Jesus, or transformed by Him?
