John 5:2-27 – The Essential Jesus – The Sabbath Switches

"Because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jewish leaders began to persecute Him." (v16)

In the final session of our series *The Essential Jesus* we're going to examine something that we come across a number of times in the gospels – Jesus coming into conflict on the Sabbath. Jesus often healed people on the Sabbath. The Jewish leaders were offended by this and considered it grounds to persecute Him.

God gave the Sabbath as a way for His people to show themselves different from the nations around them and as a gift – a day to rest and to grant their households, slaves and animals rest (Ex. 20:8-11 / Deut. 5:12-15). The author



of the letter to the Hebrews says those Sabbaths points to a true Sabbath-rest for the people of God when they rest from their all their works (Heb. 4:9-10).

This week we'll see that God's promise of rest finds its ultimate fulfilment through the ministry of Jesus. We can only find true rest because of His work on our behalf. As we'll see, the healing of the ungrateful man by the pool, shows us how we can experience this rest for ourselves.

Prayer Diary 20TH - 26TH November

Monday The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want Spend a few minutes thanking God for His extravagant love for us and the generous way He provides for all our needs - physical and spiritual. Pray for those experiencing lack now so that they may receive the support they need through kindness shown to them and through CAP, the Community Fridge, Networx, and Alpha.
