great reputation when it comes to money. I read recently that the Rwandan government closed nine thousand churches in the last year. The primary reason is Western prosperity preachers coming into the country, setting up churches and fleecing the people.

It is a disgrace and a sign of our defeat, when the church to which Jesus said, "Freely you have received, freely give" (Matt. 10:8) has a reputation for greed. To reopen, the Rwandan churches have to meet certain standards which includes theological education. That sounds like a good thing. We're going to do the same here. With God's help, we're going to learn what the Bible teaches about lifegiving giving.

I hope you'll be able to join us.

# Prayer Diary: 22<sup>nd</sup> - 28<sup>TH</sup> September

**Monday** As our nation continues to be split over issues such as immigration and national pride, we pray that the example of Christ would prevail. The virtues of compassion, grace, mercy and justice for all people regardless of status, race, gender or anything else. We pray that love would overcome hate and that, as Christians, we would demonstrate the love of Christ to all people we meet.

**Tuesday** As schools and universities restart, let us pray for all those young people leaving home for the first time, perhaps off to university or moving for work. May they encounter other Christian people, involve themselves in local churches and find strong Christian friendships. Pray too for our local schools and the Christian children in them who sometimes struggle to be open about their faith. Pray for strength and wisdom in how to navigate their school years.

**Wednesday** As the conflict in Gaza continues and famine increases, let us pray for a swift resolution so that innocent men, women and children no longer have to suffer. Whatever our theological position on Israel, let us pray that those in positions of authority have compassion, and seek truth and justice for both Jew and Palestinian. Let us pray for softened hearts and a desire for people to live in peace together.

**Thursday** Let us continue to pray for our friends in Lebedyn, Ukraine - for protection of the team and facilities - for continued conversions within the youth group and refugee population. Please pray that Farmer Sergey, Valentyn and other young men are not taken to fight. Pray for Bohdan and Alla, their marriage and family, as they lead the church and mission centre.

**Friday** Please pray for our CAP ministry. Thank God for the lives transformed by becoming debt-free. Pray too for the greater transformation of hearts and that people will come to know Jesus as their Saviour. Pray for Phil and Nadine as they work hard to overcome the barriers presented by clients that stop them becoming debt-free. Pray too for our Community Fridge ministry. Thank God for the people who serve in it and the clients who attend. Pray that conversations will be supportive and the love of Jesus will permeate every conversation.

**Saturday** This weekend, please pray for Simon and Emily as they lead our Children's and Young People's work, and for each of the different groups: Vicky Bees, Sunday School, Kids Club on Friday, Youth Club on Friday, Sunday morning youth and Xcav8 for the older youth on Sunday evening.
