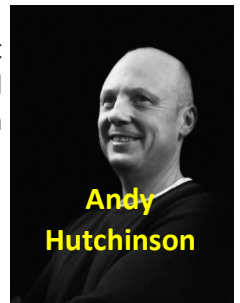

Matthew 25: 31-46

PRAYER DIARY: 23RD– 29TH May

'You are my refuge and my shield; I have put my hope in Your word' Psalm 119:114

Monday We are thankful for those who care for children at the Compassion projects in churches around the world. We pray that the sponsored children may know of the Lord's love and care for them through this project. May their hearts be filled with joy and their burdens light.

Tuesday Pray for the Alpha course now in its 5th week. Lift up the leaders, some young and new to this role, that they may be aware of the leading of the Holy Spirit. We pray that those who attend each week may 'taste and see that the Lord is good'.

Wednesday As members of the community come to buy produce at the Community Fridge today, may they enjoy a cup of tea and good conversation. For those struggling with bills and family life let them receive support, hope and love within the church community. We pray particularly for single parents to receive the help they need in caring for their families.

Thursday Eastbourne families are opening their homes to Ukrainian families. We ask Lord that, when families arrive, they may feel welcomed and safe; that they are well supported by the community and host family; receiving all the help they need in settling into a completely new life.

Friday We bring to Jesus the children who enjoy meeting on Fridays at Kids Club or Xpect. We pray that laughter may echo through the building as they meet - an experience of the joy of the Lord; that they may make good friends and hear good news from God's word. We give thanks for the leaders and volunteers who care for the children each week.

Saturday Give thanks for the work of *Good News Brighton* in Moulsecomb, Brighton led by Rev. Neil Hilton. Ask for God's continued guidance and blessing on the projects organised and the relationships being built in the community by *Good News Brighton*. We pray that Neil and his wife, Jess, may be strengthened and encouraged in the mission they are leading with 'every spiritual blessing in Christ'.

Sunday 'Lord my God, I called to You for help, and You healed me' Psalm 30:20. Many of us may have experienced a healing in our lives and we ask that those needing healing for physical, spiritual and emotional pain may come to the Healing Service by faith and receive prayer. Let this be a time of renewal and refreshing.
