## BIBLE Academy Begins again!

Bible Academy begins after Easter - two 6-week courses.



**Level 1 Bible Basics** - Alternate Thursdays at 6.30pm, starting 11<sup>th</sup> April in the Garden Room.

This course explores what the Bible is, what is the big picture behind it, how to read it and understand it. Ideal for new Christians or a good refresher course for the more mature in faith.

**Level 2 Deep Dive** - Alternate Sundays starting 14<sup>th</sup> April in the sanctuary, 6.30pm.

This course takes a more focussed approach and looks at the nature of God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit, the problem of sin, and then looks at some simple doctrines including who are the church.

check first that they are willing to stand! Any potential candidate must be a current member of VBC and have been in membership for a minimum of two years. They must also have been baptised (as an adult, not infant baptism).

Completed forms should be handed in to the office by Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March, i.e. 4 weeks in advance of the next meeting.

## Prayer Diary 25<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> March

#### The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5:16b

**Monday** - Today we pray for peace in the Middle East. Pray that those in Israel and Palestine who wish to continue violence are silenced and that the love of Christ will overpower them. Pray that those with influence will speak words of peace and reconciliation and not words of hatred. Pray for continued relief and aid to reach the people trapped in Gaza.

**Tuesday** - Please pray for our children's and young people's work. Thank God for Erik, Simon and the team of volunteers that enable this vital ministry to continue. Pray for the hearts of our children and young people to be open to the Gospel whilst juggling other commitments. Pray for creativity in planning, enthusiasm in delivery and compassion in pastoral care.

**Wednesday** - We have many groups which use VBC, including Bub Club, Rock Choir, NHS Blood and Transfusion Service, local schools, dance classes and U3A. Pray that those who come will feel the presence of God as they use the building. Pray, too, for those who come along to various ministries such as CAP, Community Fridge, Vicky Bees, the Brigades, Friends, Food and Fellowship, Men's and Women's Fellowship to name a few.

**Thursday** - Continue to pray for our brothers and sisters at our sister church in Lebedyn. As the war gets closer and impacts them more frequently, pray that they will feel the protection of the Lord. Pray that God would set His angels over the facilities, the team and those who are part of the church.

**Friday** - Today, please pray for our Life Groups. Pray for the leaders as they seek to support those in their group. Pray for wisdom in leading sessions and dealing with any pastoral concerns. Pray for those who attend groups to grow in their faith as they walk with Jesus, and ask God to raise up new leaders.

**Saturday** - Please pray for our Pastoral Team today as they support those who are sick, grieving, lonely or facing challenges in their lives. Pray that God will comfort the mourning, heal the sick, bring people alongside the lonely and give wisdom to those who are facing difficult situations. If you know of specific people who need prayer, name them before God.

**Sunday** - Today is Easter Day, or Resurrection Day, when we sing and shout *"Christ is Risen!"* Praise God and thank Him for sending Jesus. Spend time in praise of God, for His Creation, His Word and His Church. Pray for those being baptised today. May they know the fullness of God's Spirit as they commit to Him publicly.
