- A place to grow in your faith and develop your gifts

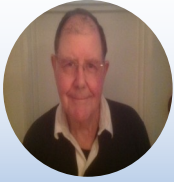

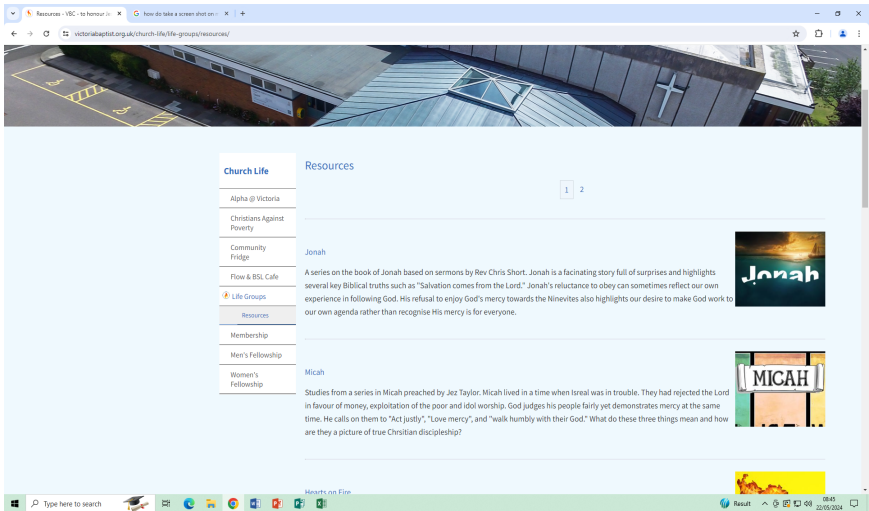
